Everything you need to turn 48 teams, one mug and a five-pound note into five weeks of office rivalry. Print it, cut it, draw it, pin it up. World Cup 2026.

A printer

Scissors

How It Works

The rules and the buy-in, start to finish.

02

The Draw

All 48 teams as cut-out tickets.

03

The Wall Chart

Who drew what, up on the wall.

04

The Awards

Six prizes worth playing for.

SHEET 01

How It Works

- 1 Print the kit**
Print all four sheets on A4. Colour looks best, but it works fine in black and white too.
- 2 Cut out the teams**
Snip along the lines on **The Draw** sheet to get 48 team tickets. Fold each one in half so the name is hidden.
- 3 Hold the draw**
Drop all 48 folded tickets into a mug, bowl or hat. Gather the office and take it in turns to pull teams out.
- 4 Take an equal share**
Everyone draws the same number of teams. It is **£5 per team** — so four teams each costs £20.
- 5 Fill the Wall Chart**
As each team is drawn, write the person's name next to it on **The Wall Chart**. Pin it up where everyone can see it.
- 6 Play for the prizes**
Follow the tournament and track **The Awards**. Hand out the prizes once the final whistle goes on 19 July.

The buy-in

Every team costs £5 to hold. With all 48 teams taken that is a £240 pot. Everyone draws an equal share of teams and pays £5 for each one — so in a 12-person office that is 4 teams and £20 a head. The whole pot then gets shared across the six awards on Sheet 04.

IF THE NUMBERS DON'T DIVIDE EVENLY

48 won't always split cleanly between your players. Any leftover teams can be drawn into a shared "wildcard" pool that pays into the pot, handed to whoever organised it, or simply left out. Your office, your call — just agree it before the draw.



SHEET 02

The Draw

Cut along the dashed lines for 48 team tickets. Fold each in half, drop them in a mug, and draw in person.

01 The Champion**OVERALL WINNER**

The team that lifts the World Cup trophy on 19 July. The big one.

PRIZE _____ WINNER _____

02 The Thunderbastard**FURTHEST GOAL**

Awarded for the single goal scored from the greatest distance anywhere in the tournament. The screamer of screamers.

PRIZE _____ WINNER _____

03 The Enforcer**DIRTIEST TEAM**

Most disciplinary points across all matches. Yellow card = 1 point. Red card = 3 points. Add them up.

PRIZE _____ WINNER _____

04 The Wooden Spoon**WORST TEAM**

For the team that finishes with no points and no goals — or comes closest to it. Someone has to win the booby prize.

PRIZE _____ WINNER _____

05 The Gambler**MOST SHOOTOUTS**

For the team involved in the most penalty shootouts. Lived and died by the spot.

PRIZE _____ WINNER _____

06 The Entertainer**MOST FUN TEAM**

For the team that scores the most goals across the tournament. Win or lose, they gave everyone a show.

PRIZE _____ WINNER _____

Splitting the £240 pot is up to you — a common split is a big share to **The Champion**, a solid share to **The Entertainer** and **The Thunderbastard**, and a token prize for **The Wooden Spoon**. Or skip the cash entirely and play for bragging rights and who buys the coffees.
